Electives currently offered at QTC include: Biblical Theology of Mission, Ethics, Philosophy/Apologetics, Australian Church History, Hermeneutics, Christian Worship, Evangelism, and subjects in Pastoral Care and Preaching. From 2009, it is intended that we will also offer several subjects in Children's & Youth Ministry.

A fourth year of study is available. Some students (those with a GPA of 2.8 or better) might choose to complete the BTh(Honours) year. Others, who wish to take more electives to be better prepared for ministry, enrol in a 4-year combined degree, the BTh/BMin.

The Fine Print:

- Biblical Hebrew A & B are elective subjects, however we would encourage most students to give Hebrew a go for a year.
- Most electives are only offered every second year. Students should discuss their choice of electives with the Faculty. We don't generally recommend that students who have not comfortably passed all of their subjects in First Year take five rather than four subjects per Semester in Second Year.
- Subject offerings and timetabling may vary slightly from the above in future years.
- The minimum requirement to complete either the BTh is 24 Semester units.
- The combined BTh/BMin degree is currently under revision through our accrediting body, the Australian College of Theology (ACTh). It is proposed to reduce the requirements for this course to 32 Semester units taken over four years full-time. Further details will be made available in the coming months.
