Electives currently offered at QTC include: Biblical Theology of Mission, Ethics, Philosophy/Apologetics, Australian Church History, Hermeneutics, Christian Worship, Evangelism, an Exit Project (for those considering postgraduate research), and subjects in Pastoral Care and Preaching. From 2009, it is intended that we will also offer several subjects in Children's & Youth Ministry.

A fourth year of study is available. Some students, who wish to take more electives to be better prepared for ministry, enrol in a 4-year combined degree, the MDiv/GradDipDiv.

### The Fine Print:

- Biblical Hebrew A & B are elective subjects, however we would encourage most students to give Hebrew a go for a year.
- Most electives are only offered every second year. Students should discuss their choice of electives with the Faculty. We don't generally recommend that students who have not comfortably passed all of their subjects in First Year take five rather than four subjects per Semester in Second Year.
- Subject offerings and scheduling may vary slightly from the above in future years.
- The minimum requirement to complete the MDiv is 24 Semester units.
