Students wishing to take additional electives may complete a combined BTh/DipMin General Pathway.

If Biblical Hebrew A and B are taken in second year, students must ensure that they include at least six exegesis units in their course.

If a student wishes to change their pathway after completing their first year in the General Pathway, they may do so with approval from QTC, through the Registrar.

Part-time students complete the same units as listed above but over a period of up to 9 years. Attention should be paid to ACT prerequisites: see the ACT Undergraduate Handbook for details.
