Available electives include: Mission Perspectives (EM301), Ministry in Islamic Contexts (EM415), Ministry in a Culturally Diverse Context (EM418), Intro to Church-based Children's Ministry (DM320), Foundations for Youth Ministry (DM310), Australian Church History (CH409), Christian Worship (PC315), Pastoral Skills and Methods (PC403), Philosophy (PE425), the Bible in Context Study Tour (BB445), Apologetics (PE420), and more. Students wishing to take additional electives may complete a combined BTh/BMin General Pathway. A BTh(Honours) option is also available.

If Biblical Hebrew A and B are taken in second year, students must ensure that they include at least six exegesis units in their course, including Romans, a Gospel unit and Pentateuch if possible.

If a student wishes to change their pathway after completing their first year in the General Pathway, they may do so with approval from QTC, through the Registrar.
