The above set requirements represent a complete course that will lead to a specialization in Women's Ministry within the award of the BTh, in the timeframe indicated. Students may also include further units as electives in addition to the above in their second or third year, provided they don't enrol in more than 20cps of units in any Semester.

Those enrolled in the Women's Ministry pathway will also attend and assist with the QTC Ministry to Women (M2W) course in one of their three years at QTC, and participate in a preaching group as part of their training in Women's Ministry. Students are also encouraged to participate in QTC Women activities and one-to-one Gospel Coaching with an experienced mentor.

If Biblical Hebrew A and B are taken in second or third year, students must ensure that they include at least six exegesis units in their course, including Romans, a Gospel unit and, if possible Pentateuch.

Available electives include: Mission Perspectives (EM301), Ministry in Islamic Contexts (EM415), Ministry in Cross-Cultural Contexts (EM418), Intro to Church-based Children's Ministry (DM320), Foundations for Youth Ministry (DM310), Australian Church History (CH409), Christian Worship (PC315), Philosophy (PE425), the Bible in Context field trip (BB445), Apologetics (PE420), and more. Students wishing to take additional electives may complete a combined BTh/DipMin Women's Ministry Pathway.

If a student wishes to change their pathway after completing the first year in the General Pathway, they may do so with approval from QTC, through the Registrar. Part-time students complete the same units as listed above but over a period of up to 9 years.
