Available electives include: Mission Perspectives (EM501), Ministry in Islamic Contexts (EM615), Ministry in Cross-Cultural Contexts (EM618), Intro to Church-based Children's Ministry (DM520), Foundations for Youth Ministry (DM510), Australian Church History (CH609), History of Evangelical Christianity (CH625), Christian Worship (PC515), Philosophy (PE625), the Bible in Context field trip (BB645), Apologetics (PE620), and more. Students wishing to complete additional electives may complete either a combined MDiv/GradDipDiv or a combined MDiv with GradCertDiv General Pathway.

The inclusion of either a Project (8 credit points) or Capstone Seminar (TH689) is required to complete the MDiv, as is the inclusion of at least two OT and/or NT units in the Greek or Hebrew text in second and third year.

If a student wishes to change their pathway after completing the first year in the General Pathway, they may do so with approval from QTC, through the Registrar. Part-time students complete the same units as listed above but over a period of up to 9 years.
