Students will be involved in youth and/or children's ministry in a local church or school RI setting.

Available electives include: Mission Perspectives (EM501), Ministry in Islamic Contexts (EM615), Ministry in Cross-Cultural Contexts (EM618), Australian Church History (CH609), Christian Worship (PC515), Philosophy (PE625), the Bible in Context field trip (BB645), Apologetics (PE620) and more.

The inclusion of a Project (8cp) or Capstone Seminar (TH689) is required to complete the MDiv, as is the inclusion of at least two OT and/or NT units in the Greek or Hebrew text across second and third year. The OT/NT units should include Romans, a Gospels unit, and, if possible Pentateuch, and must total at least four OT/NT units completed for credit in second and third year.

If a student wishes to change their pathway after completing the first year in the General Pathway, they may do so with approval from QTC, through the Registrar. Part-time students complete the same units as listed above but over a period of up to 9 years.
