Those enrolled in the Pastor's pathway will also enrol and participate in a QTC weekly preaching workshop in each year of their course, after completing PC647, as well as other activities decided on on a year by year basis.

Available electives include: Mission Perspectives (EM501), Ministry in Islamic Contexts (EM615), Ministry in Cross-Cultural Contexts (EM618), Intro to Church-based Children's Ministry (DM520), Foundations for Youth Ministry (DM510), the Bible in Context field trip (BB645), Apologetics (PE620) and more. In third or fourth year, students may under certain circumstances also take up to two of our MA units (4cp version) as electives.

The inclusion of either a Project (8cp) or Capstone Seminar (TH689) is required to complete the MDiv, as is the inclusion of at least two OT and/or NT units in the Greek and Hebrew text across second and third year.
