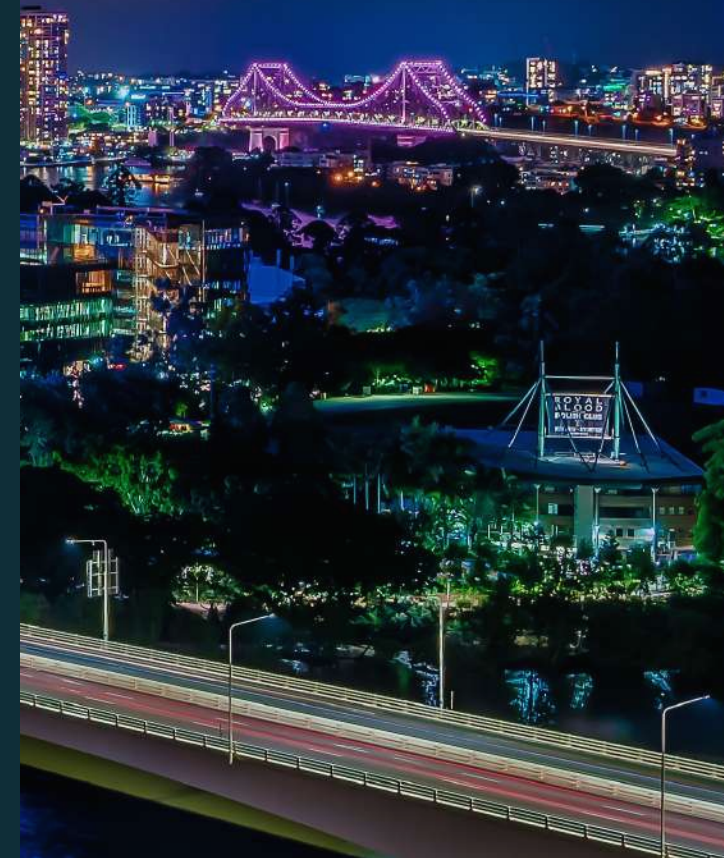

WORKPLACE EVANGELISM PATHWAY

Fewer Australians find themselves in church, if we're going to reach our world we need to see the workplace as our mission field ripe for the harvest.

The Workplace Evangelism Pathway is a guided journey to allow QTC students to consider how to apply what they learn at college to the situation in which God will place them - their workplace.

Pathway participants will be coached in workplace evangelism and be better prepared to share Jesus in their context - and to train other Christians in evangelism.

The 2 aspects of the pathway are:

- **Training in evangelism in a contemporary Australian context**
- **Mentoring towards a holistic development of the student for workplace evangelism**

The Workplace Evangelism Pathway will provide periodic training in a theological, philosophical, and practical approach to evangelism in contemporary Australia; and provide mentoring for students to help them make progress in their life and doctrine.

The pathway will run on 4 Mondays over the year.

Each Monday will have

- a time of training for workplace evangelism,
- a time of reflection and prayer,
- a time for meeting with mentors.
