

Assistant Minister

Job Summary: Bargara Presbyterian Church is seeking a godly, gifted, and compatible Assistant Minister to join our ministry team. The successful candidate will be responsible for leading and coordinating the Youth and Young adult's ministry area. In addition, the Assistant Minister will be expected to do some preaching. While we recognize the need for a clear job description for clarity of role and purpose, we're also aware of the need for some flexibility in this, depending on the gifts of the individual and the changing needs of the Church. Given that gospel ministry is by nature relational, and relationships take time, we're looking for someone who may be open to staying in Bargara longer term. To begin with, this position will be parttime, with the prayerful hope that it might increase to a fulltime position (we're open to other options here as well: for example, the option of fulltime with 40% self-raised funding).

Responsibilities:

- Lead and coordinate the Youth and Young Adults ministry area, including recruiting, training, and working with the teams.
- Develop leaders in the Youth, and Young Adults area with the view to over time transition to oversee a team of leaders in these areas.
- Preach 5 times a year (If part time)
- Collaborate with the ministry team in the implementation of the church's overall vision, mission and goals.
- Participate in pastoral care of the congregation as needed.

Requirements:

- A deep personal faith in Jesus Christ and a commitment to gospel ministry.
- A love for people, a heart for mission and a passion for discipleship.
- A theological education.
- Strong leadership and organizational skills, with experience in recruiting, training, and developing leaders.
- Excellent communication skills, including preaching and teaching.
- A willingness to commit to the Bargara Church family for the longer term.
- A commitment to the Values and Vision of Bargara Presbyterian church.

Preferred:

- Experience in Kids, Youth, Young Adults ministry.
- Open to the possibility of ordination in the Presbyterian Church in Australia.
- Administrative ability in a Church context.
