Position Description

Purpose: The purpose of this role is to help the Women and Children's ministry coordinator to lead kids to Christ and assist with various admin tasks related to this. To build relationship with these children and their parents.

Key Duties

- Ability to write kids bible lessons and run the class of different aged kids
- Help with recruiting, training, and coordinating volunteer leaders to assist with the running of children's program and activities.
- Helping prepare craft activities for Village Kids and play group on Friday's
- Preparing promotional material for events and activities that Village kids and play group hold
- Ability to lead our community play group in order to free up the Women and Children's ministry coordinator to talk to women.
- Manage social media for play group and special events for kids eg Holiday Club.

All member's of the Village ministry team are required to:

- Attend regular staff meetings on Tuesdays, as required
- Assist in other ministry areas as needed, within reason;
- Obtain (or currently hold) a Blue Card which involves appropriate background checks; and
- Complete mandatory "PresSafe" training (organised through PCQ)
